Our Houses

To accommodate missionary families, 3 ranch houses were purchased on land adjacent to the seminary in 1960, 1969, and 1972. Unlike the Lapsley and Adle buildings, we own the property on which these houses stand.



The house at 211 contains 3 bedrooms and 2 baths. Its purchase was primarily funded by gifts in memory of Frances Moss Carroll.

The house at 207 contains 4 bedrooms and 2 baths. Local donations and volunteer labor created a community exercise room in the basement of this home.

The house at 167 contains 3 bedrooms and 2½ baths. There is a meeting room in the basement which is available to PW circles upon request.

Fun Fact

The Entrance Marker for Mission Haven was dedicated on Easter Sunday, March 26, 1967. The bronze plaque and brick wall are a permanent memorial to William Dennis, the husband of Sarah Dennis who was the first Executive Director of Mission Haven.
