THREE GENERATIONS: *Mission Service*

1st Generation: For 40 years, beginning in 1954, the **Rev. David Miller** and his wife **Polly**, faithfully served the PC(USA) in Congo, Lesotho, Zimbabwe, and elsewhere in Africa. The Millers' first assignment took them to Luebo Station in the Belgian Congo, where their children were born. Together, they raised three children: David, Nancy, and Eddie. The Millers were among the first to live in 167 after it was purchased in the early 1970's.

2nd Generation: The Millers' daughter, **Nancy (Miller) Dimmock**, grew up in the Congo. She and her husband, **Frank**, beginning in 1985, also devoted their careers to mission service for over 30 years, much of it to public health ministries in Africa, especially the health and well-being of children.

After college she joined a mission group providing clean water to Malawi, and met her husband, **Saul Huber**, when he joined one of the mission trips in 2012. They are now young adult mobilizers for EPC World Outreach. They love discipling young adults and coordinating local and international mission encounters to help them discern God's calling on their lives.
