WITH YOU ALWAYS: A report from Jim McGill

Former PCUSA mission co-worker and frequent resident of Mission Haven Jim McGill attended several workshops at this year's [New Wilmington Mission Conference \(NWMC\)](#).

Among them were "With You Always" workshops which highlighted ideas and strategies to support those who are called to long-term, cross-cultural mission service.

"With You Always" (WYA) is a Presbyterian initiative "seeking to recognize the faithful service of PCUSA mission co-workers, reconnect [those called to mission with congregations and presbyteries and mission networks] in shared calling, and discern new pathways for global mission through partnership, prayer, and vision."

In addition, several of the Mission Networks met during the week. They emphasized continued collaboration between Presbyterian congregations and church partners. Jim attended the Niger and South Sudan Mission Networks, which are looking at ways to become better, more effective partners in mutual mission.

For Jim, it was especially encouraging to discover that Presbyterians in the pews still want to be a part of the sending and support of those called to cross-cultural mission work.
